Sir:

Reference is made to the pending case against you regarding the samples of STERILIZED and RAW COW MILK taken from your plant which were found violating the Food Law, rules and regulations, and to the hearing accorded you in this Office on July 30, 1943, in connection with the other samples taken on June 30 and July 7, 1943, by Assistant Food Inspector Dr. Manuel V. Olympia, Jr. of this Office which were likewise found violating the Food Law, rules and regulations.

You are informed that this Office is in receipt of the reports of analyses on the samples of milk taken on July 14, 1943, by Assistant Food Inspector Leonardo Pañgilinan of this Bureau and, as it appears therein that they comply with the Food Law, rules and regulations, it is hereby requested that efforts be exerted to maintain the good quality of your product by seeing to it that the milk shall always be sterilized to the minimum temperature of 100°C or 212°F and maintained at the boiling point for at least five minutes; and by accepting from milk suppliers only milk that contains not less than 3%, otherwise this Office will be constrained to take drastic action against you for whatever violation of the Food Law, rules and regulations that may be found on subsequent samples that will be taken from that establishment.
