Gentlemen:

Since the transfer of Management of the properties of the former Manila Electric Company to Taiwan Denryoku Kaisya, your privilege of using electric service free of charge was taken into consideration. After a careful study of your case by the officials of the Company concerned, it was decided to discontinue giving you this privilege on the ground that if your institution need any material help it should come from the government or from some civic spirited individuals.

It was further reasoned out that it is not the practice of the present Company to donate, even at their home office, electric service to charitable institution free of charge.

You were being given, however, time of grace until December of this year to continue using our service under the same condition so that you may have ample time to adjust your financial conditions.

We regret very much that under the above conditions we have to discontinue this special privilege although we realize the aim and purpose of your institution.

Beginning January, 1944, we shall render your monthly bills based on the existing schedules of the Company which we trust will not be much of a financial burden to your institution.
